Association Communautaire de Vars (AC Vars)

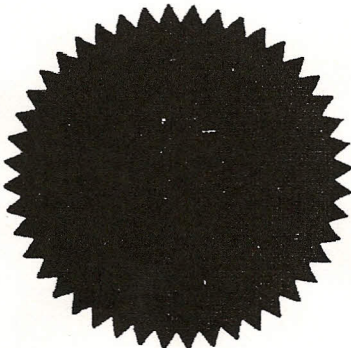

**Application for Incorporation of a Corporation  
without share capital under Part II of the *Canada Corporations Act***

To the Minister of Industry:

The undersigned hereby apply to the Minister of Industry for the grant of a charter by letters patent under the provisions of Part II of the *Canada Corporations Act* constituting the undersigned, and such others as may become members of the Corporation thereby created, a body corporate and politic under the name of

**Vars Community Association (Vars CA) / Association Communautaire de Vars (AC Vars)**

The undersigned have satisfied themselves and are assured that the proposed name under which incorporation is sought is not the same or similar to the name under which any other company, society, association or firm in existence is carrying on business in Canada or is incorporated under the laws of Canada or any province thereof so nearly resembles the same as to be calculated to deceive and that it is not a name which is otherwise on public grounds objectionable.

The said John Tossounian, Tom McMahon, Alex Reid, Carl Roth and are among the first directors of the Corporation (the interim Executive Committee consists of 7 directors whose term expires in September 2002, when a full-term Executive Committee will be elected, the other directors, Anne Sabourin, Carole Brisson-Roy and Barb Lavictoire has consented to be directors on the Interim Executive Committee).

The objects of the Corporation are: to develop and foster community spirit; to promote, encourage and assist the educational, charitable and recreational endeavours of the community; to promote the development of recreational activities and facilities; to promote cultural life in the community; to hold public meetings to consider and discuss all questions affecting the interests of the community; to develop, operate and maintain a web site for the purpose of promoting communication to and between residents of the Vars area; to promote the development and implementation of a specific plan for the Vars area; to detail the history of the community; to promote the development and realization of a community hall for Vars; and to promote new services represented by needs and

interests of the community; all on a non-profit, non-sectarian and non-political basis, including the recognition and promotion of the respect for the two official languages in the community.

The Association will achieve its objectives by applying for grants, soliciting contributions, representing the community's interests to the appropriate levels of government on a neutral basis, and volunteering time and skills.

The corporation shall be carried on without the purpose of gain for its members and any profits or other accretions to the corporation shall be used in promoting its objects. The corporation shall be subject to the applicable governing legislation. For the above objects, and as incidental and ancillary thereto, the Association may exercise any of the powers normally associated with a non-profit, charitable corporation, except where such power is limited by these letters patent or the statute or common law relating to charities.

These objects are consistent with the objects of community associations that have been recognized by CCRA and are modelled on those objects. The Vars CA will apply for recognition as a registered charity with CCRA.

The operations of the Corporation may be carried on throughout Canada and elsewhere.

The place within Canada where the head office of the corporation is to be situated is Vars, within the boundaries of the City of Ottawa, Ontario

It is specially provided that in the event of liquidation, dissolution or winding-up of the corporation, all of its remaining assets after payment of its liabilities shall be distributed to one or more registered charitable organizations in Canada.

The by-laws of the corporation shall be those filed with the application for letters patent until repealed, amended, altered or added to.

The corporation is to carry on its operations without pecuniary gain to its members and any profits or other accretions to the corporation are to be used in promoting its objects.


